What an astonishing 10 years it has been! Since opening our doors in 2006, WC SAFE has grown to 17 staff members and 5 clinic locations. We have served over 10,000 sexual assault survivors, including over 400 of the survivors of the untested rape kits found by Kym Worthy in a Detroit warehouse, and provided over 5,000 medical forensic exams (rape kits).

It is never taken for granted by myself or our staff and board that we serve at the request of our community's sexual assault and human trafficking survivors, and it is our duty to not only meet their needs on their healing journey, but to help eradicate sexual violence and rape culture from our community. We couldn't do this without the support of our donors, volunteers, and board members.

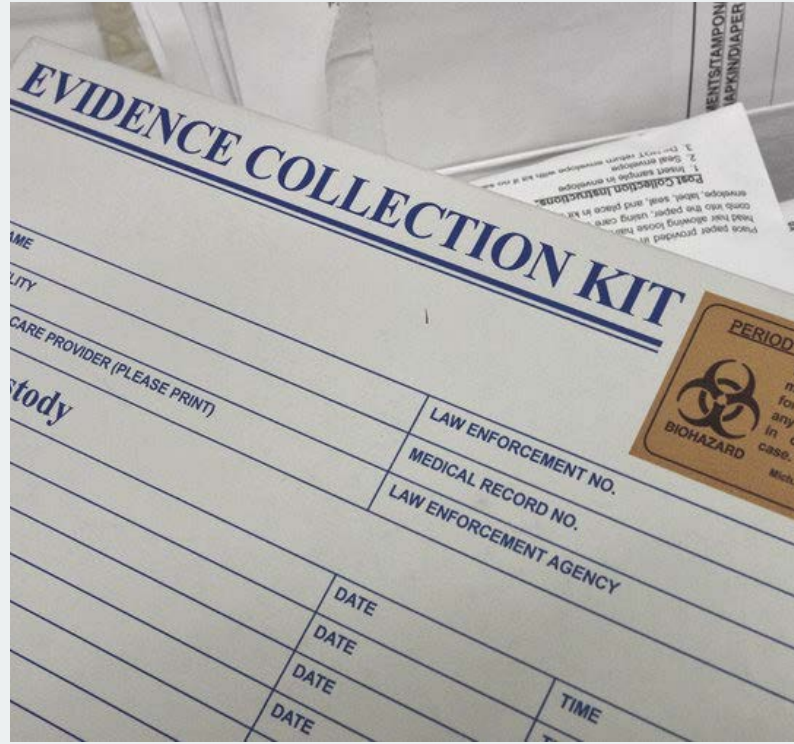
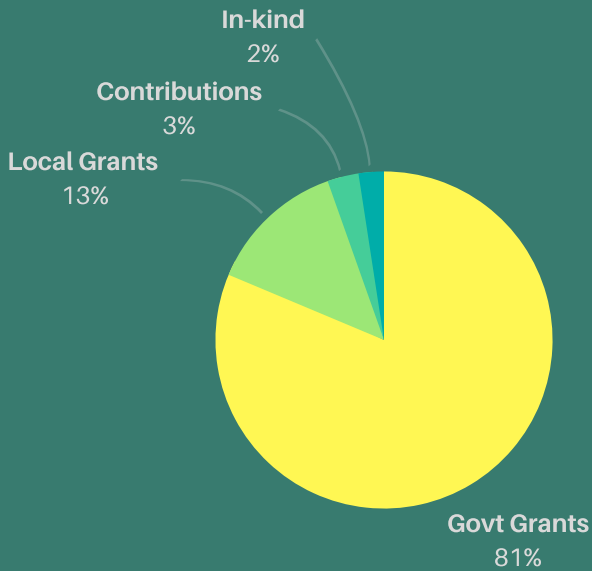

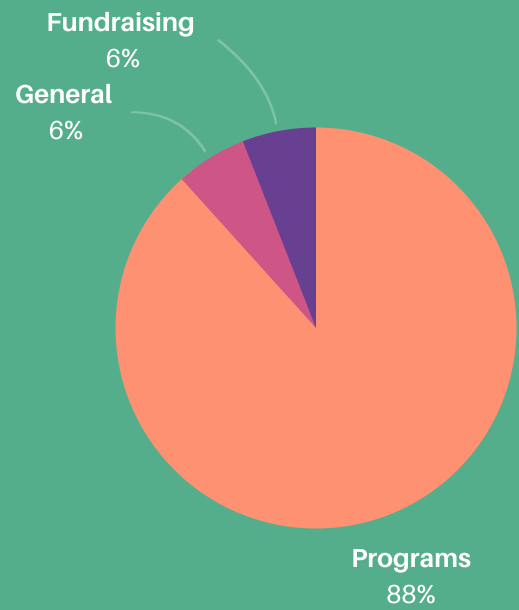
